



## RUBBER DUCKY FAVOR

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 4 in. x 9 in. Yellow Felt for duck body
- 1 in. x 7 in. Yellow Felt \* for gusset
- 1 in. x 2 in. Orange felt for beak
- 2 qty. - 15mm Moving Eyes
- Pen for tracing
- Scissors
- Low Temp Glue Gun & Glue Sticks

NOTE: You can make the gusset strip a little wider, maybe 1.5 in., if you prefer.



### INSTRUCTIONS



1. Cut out and trace the rubber ducky pattern on to one side of the felt.

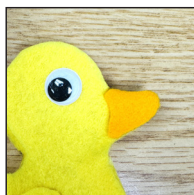


6. Position a wing on each body and glue in place.

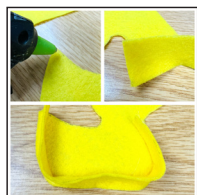


2. Fold the felt in half and cut out two duck pieces.

Trace the wing pattern onto the remaining scrap felt. Cut out for two duck wings.



7. Trace pattern and cut out two beaks from orange felt. Align with the duck's faces and glue beaks on.

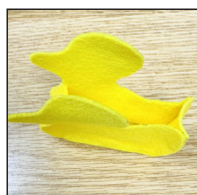


3. Take one duck body piece and starting from the tail, add a line of glue along the edge. Align one edge of the felt strip to the duck body and glue together. Continue gluing the strip to the edge of the duck outline. You should end at the bottom of the duck's neck. Because the felt may stretch, trim excess off from the strip if needed.



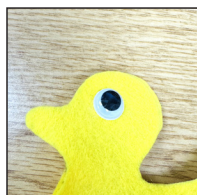
8. Fill with treats.

Optional - you can place the duck in a clear bag tied with a bow for a finishing touch



4. Glue the other duck body piece to the other side of the strip.

This creates the main favor piece

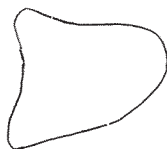


5. Glue one moving eye to each duck head.



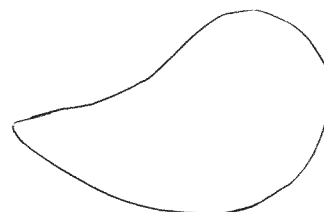


## RUBBER DUCKY FAVOR PATTERN



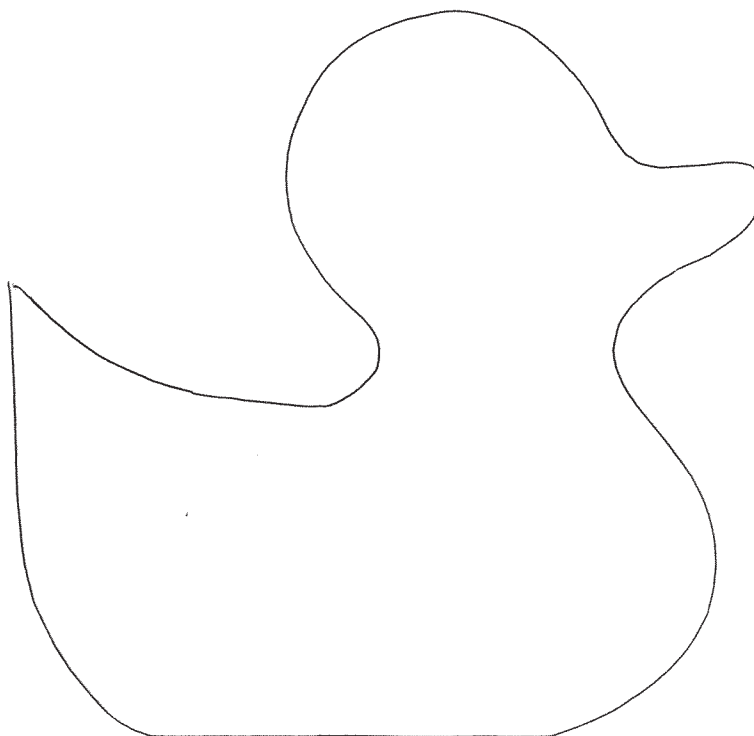
**BEAK**
