



# CANDY BOUQUET

## SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 5 qty. candy bars/bags
- 5 qty. bamboo chopsticks or 12" wood dowels
- Cellophane wrap - one or more colors
- Mylar sheets
- Clear tape
- Clear Packing Tape
- Scissors
- Vase/Container for bouquet
- Styrofoam, Krinkle Shreds or marbles for container filler
- **Optional:** Curling Ribbon



## INSTRUCTIONS



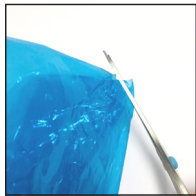
1. Take each candy bar/bag and lay flat in front of you. Place the chopstick or dowel in the center and use the packing tape to attach. Set aside for now.



2. Take the cellophane and Mylar sheets and cut into 10" -12" squares. They do not have to be perfect in size but cut the edges nicely so that it isn't jagged. Cut 5 of each, one set for each candy bar.



3. Fold each cellophane/Mylar piece into fourths. At the center point, make a small diagonal snip to create a tiny hole.



4. Take a cellophane sheet. Slip the stick of the candy bar/bag through the hole.



5. Twist and gather up the cellophane around the stick below the candy bar/bag. Use regular clear tape and tape around to hold the cellophane in place.



6. Next, slip a Mylar sheet onto the stick. Twist and gather the Mylar and tape to the stick below the cellophane.

Repeat steps 4-6 with the remaining candy bars/bags.



7. **Optional:** Tie some curling ribbon onto the stick below the gathered wraps. The ribbon adds a finishing touch if people take apart the bouquet to share individual candies with others.



8. **Make an arrangement** - Place a piece of Styrofoam or some Krinkle Paper Shreds or a bunch of marbles inside of a vase/container. Stick the candy bars/bags in, arranging them and letting the "fluff" of the Mylar and cellophane fill out the arrangement.
