



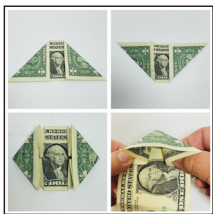
DOLLAR BILL ORIGAMI HEART

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Crisp & Clean Dollar bill or similar paper size
- Optional: Paper Creaser



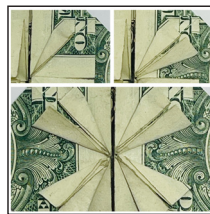
INSTRUCTIONS



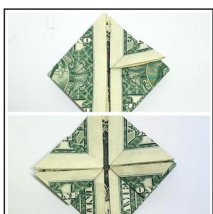
1. With the face side of the dollar bill facing up, fold each corner in to the opposite side edge and crease well.

This should create an "x" on each side.

Push in the sides of the "x" and flatten each side. This should create two large triangles with a space in the center.



2. Bring the two triangles together, meeting at the center and fold over the excess center to the back.



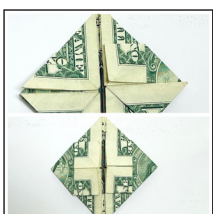
3. Lift each top flap and fold point up to the center. Crease well.

Do this for each of the four points. This should create two small squares/diamonds on the top layer.



4. Open up each folded flap and flatten to form a smaller square.

Do this for all four, creating four small squares on the top layer.



5. For each of the small squares, fold each side point to the center.

6. Open up each of the folded side points on each square.

7. Fold the top down to the back, revealing the top curve of the heart.

On the left and right-side points, fold about 1/4-in. to the back to finish shaping the heart.



8. Uses for the finished dollar bill heart:

Keep in your wallet as a lucky charm.

Use it to embellish a card front. Use three hearts together and make a shamrock.

Slip several hearts into a clear sleeve to make a lei.
