WRAPPED WITH LOVE HEARTS

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Chipboard #30153055
- Yarn - your choice
- Pen/pencil for tracing
- Scratch paper for pattern template
- Scissors

Options for finishing:

- Frame, Canvas or wood piece to mount heart
- Ribbon for hanging
- Hot Glue Gun & Glue sticks

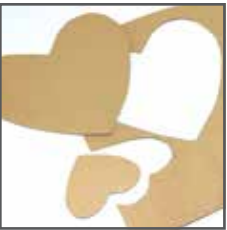
NOTE: Sample used one skein of Sugar 'n Cream yarn



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Using scratch paper, cut out a heart shape in the size you want.



2. Trace heart template onto the chipboard and cut out.



3. Take the yarn and wrap around the chipboard heart, leaving a tail end. Wrap the yarn in different directions, turning the heart as needed to keep the layers even.



4. After the heart is at least half covered, take the tail end from the beginning and weave into the layers, tie off and knot securely. Keep wrapping the heart until it is fully covered. Weave in the end of the yarn and tie off and knot securely. Cut off excess yarn.



5. Finishing Ideas- Mount the heart on a picture frame, canvas or wood surface using a hot glue gun to secure.



6. You can also tuck in photos, flowers or other embellishments between the yarn layers.



7. If you made small hearts, string several hearts together on a ribbon or braided yarn for a garland.
