

2 PAPER HEART POCKETS

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 2 qty. - 9-in. x 4-in. Patterned Paper - two coordinating prints
- 1/4-in. Double Stick Tape #30013284
- 8-in. of ribbon or cord for the hanger
- Pencil for tracing
- Score Board #30195075
- Scissors
- 1/4-in. Hole Punch #77178558
- Optional - Clear bag and ribbon for packaging

NOTE: To create the curved edge of the pattern, a circle die from the Sizzix Framelits Nested Circle die set #30124869 was traced. You can experiment and use different circle sizes to create different heart sizes.



INSTRUCTIONS

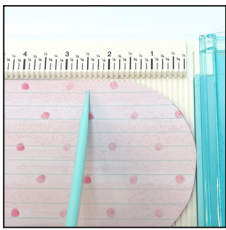


1. Trace the pattern onto the wrong side of the patterned papers, one of each printed design.

Cut the two pieces out.



5. Use the 1/4-in. hole punch to make a hole at the center of the top of the heart.



2. Place one piece onto the score board with the longer length along the top edge.

Score at the 2 1/2-in. mark.

Repeat with the second piece.



6. Thread the ribbon/cord through the hole and knot to create the hanger.



3. Overlap the two pieces, forming an "X". Matching the edges with the scored line. Tape the two pieces together at the square.



7. Fill the pocket with small treats or a gift card.



4. At the scored edges, fold the curved flap edges up, overlapping each other. Tape the top flap to the other flap to create the pocket.



8. You can hang the pocket on the wall or doorknob.

You can also slip the pocket into a clear bag and wrap it up to give as a gift.
