



BUBBLE WRAP PAINTING - HYDRANGEA

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

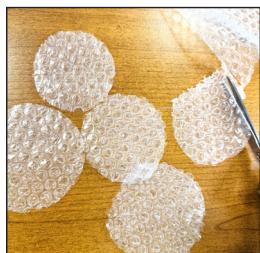
- 11 x 14 Canvas Panel #30249812
- Bubble Wrap #90752
- Acrylic Paints:
 - Ceramcoat Tahiti Blue #302509097
 - Ceramcoat Passion Purple #30084944
 - Ceramcoat Exotic Orchid #30214870
 - Ceramcoat White #77624882
 - Ceramcoat Green
- Q-Tips
- 1-inch Foam Brush #30100057 - painting background
- Med. Round tip paintbrush -painting stems, leaves
- Scissors



INSTRUCTIONS

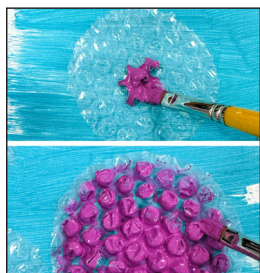


1. Use a flat brush to paint the canvas panel with the blue paint. Let dry.



2. Cut circles out of the bubble wrap. Cut out an odd number of circles, one for each flower. You can make them different sizes for added interest.

You can place the circles on the canvas to get an idea of your design.



3. With the bubble side facing up, add purple paint onto the bubble wrap circle. Use the paintbrush to spread the paint around the bubble wrap.

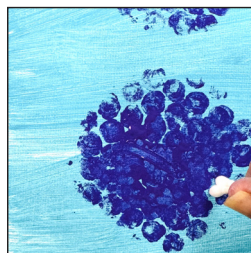


4. Carefully lift each circle and place onto the canvas, paint side down. Slightly press over the back of the bubble wrap to get the paint onto the canvas.



5. Lift off the bubble wrap to reveal the painted circle.

Continue adding more painted circles.



6. While the painted circles are still wet, hold two Q-tips together and pounce on the paint to shape the design.



7. Use two new Q-Tips with white paint and add highlights with the same pouncing technique, especially on the top and sides to shape the flower.



8. Use the medium round tip paintbrush with the green paint to make flower stems and leaves.

Let dry.
