



LOVE YOUR PET TREAT JARS

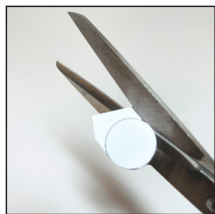
SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 1pc. of 2.55-in. Plastic jar #30200501
- 1 pc. of 2.5-in. x 11-in. - 12-in. Cardstock for jar wrap around
- 1 pc. of 4-in. x 4-in. Cardstock for jar top
- 2 pcs. of 2-in. x 5.5-in. Cardstock for dog/bunny ears
- Optional: 2 pcs. of 1.5-in. x 5-in. Light Pink or Beige Cardstock for inner ears dog/bunny
- 2 pcs. of 2.5-in. x 2.5-in. Cardstock for cat ears
- 2 pcs. of 2-in. x 2-in. Light Pink Cardstock for inner cat ears
- 1 pc. of 1-in. x 2-in. White Cardstock for the eyes
- 1 pc. 1-in. x 1-in. of Pink or Black Cardstock for the nose
- Additional scraps of Cardstock for details like stripes, spots, whiskers, etc.
- Ribbon, Flowers, etc. for additional embellishments
- 1/4-in. Double stick tape #30013284
- Pop Up Glue Dots #30001511
- Black Marker for details Sharpie #91029
- Dime, Nickel, Penny for tracing to make eyes
- Pen/pencil for tracing
- Optional: Circle punches (1/2-in. #30028691 - 1-in. #30028719 sizes) instead of tracing circles from coins
- Scissors
- Paper trimmer #30088131
- Treats to fill jars

NOTE: Dog sample used 3.93-in. plastic jar #30200500



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Fold the 1-in. x 2-in. white cardstock in half. Take a dime and trace onto one side. Cut out through both thicknesses to make two eyes.



2. Use the black marker to draw smaller circles on top of the white circles to complete the eyes. Place onto the cardstock strip for the wrap around and tape in place.



3. Cut out a triangle or heart for the nose and tape below the eyes. Add other details like a mouth and/or whiskers with cardstock or draw with the marker. Place the wrap inside of the empty jar.



4. Take the 4-in. x 4-in. cardstock and place down with the wrong side facing up. Remove the foam circle from inside the jar lid and center on the cardstock. Trace the circle and cut out. Place the cardstock circle into the jar lid.



5. With the cardstock for the outer ears, draw and cut out two ears. For the cat, make rounded top triangles. For the bunny or dog, make elongated teardrops. Make slightly smaller pieces with the pink or a light color for the inner ears. Center and tape the inner ears to the outer ears. At the bottom of each ear, fold up about 1/4-in. along the straight edge.



6. Screw the lid onto the empty jar. With the animal face forward, position the ears on the lid. For the dog, you will place the ears to the sides and have them come down over the edge. Tape the folded edges of the ears to the jar lid.



Decorate by adding flowers, bows, etc. on top of the jar lid between the ears as desired.

7. Unscrew the lid and fill the jars with wrapped treats.
