



HEARTY CLAY MALASADAS

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- White Hearty Clay #77856070
- Acrylic Paint - Ceramcoat Golden Brown #77625012
- Clear Varnish - Satin #30119193
- Crystal Glitter #77566026
- Sharpie Marker - Fine Tip Black #91029
- Paint Brush
- Tacky Glue #1360916
- Paper Towel
- Glue Gun & Glue Sticks
- Zip Loc bags and/or air tight containers for clay storage

Optional:

- Disposable gloves for mixing paint in clay
- Soft Pastels for shading #77829150
- Pin Back



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Pull out some white Hearty clay. Add some Golden Brown paint to the clay and mix the color into the clay. Add more paint as needed, until you like the color. Make sure the color is evenly mixed throughout the clay.

NOTE: The clay will get a little sticky from adding in the paint. You may want to wear gloves.



2. Roll the brown clay into an oblong ball like a malasada shape. Size it to what you want for a small embellishment.



3. If you want to add more detail, brush on some chalks or paint to contour the piece. Or add color for cheeks.

Place on a paper towel to dry.



4. After the clay has dried, brush on a light coat of clear matte varnish.



5. While the varnish is still wet, sprinkle on the clear glitter for "sugar". Leave some space in the center without glitter if you want to add a face.

Let dry.



6. After the piece is dried, you can add on a face if you want. Use the marker or black acrylic paint to make tiny dot eyes and a smile.

Glue on a pin back or magnet to the back of the piece.

You can also use this as an embellishment for other projects like a gift box or a little sign.



7. You can also make a stack of tiny malasadas instead of one big one.

Be creative and have fun making different sizes for different projects.
