ORIGAMI CAT BOOK MARKER

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 6 in. x 6 in. paper/cardstock*
- White and light green scrap cardstock for eyes
- Black cardstock for eyes, nose
- Black Marker
- 1/4-inch double stick tape
- Scissors

Optional:

- circle punches for eyes, nose
- Paper Creaser tool


Optional:

- Tacky Glue, low temp glue gun or double stick tape


NOTE: Using cardstock will make the book marker thicker and is a little harder to fold.




INSTRUCTIONS




1. With the paper on point, fold in half, bottom point to top point. Crease well.




2. Take the top point of just the top layer and fold down to the bottom point. You have formed a pocket.




3. Fold each side point to the center top point. Crease well.



4. Fold each point down to the side at an angle, as shown.



5. Lift and tuck into the pocket to form the ears.



6. Tucked in points form the ears.



7. Use punches or cut out eyes and nose from cardstock and tape in place. Draw in eyes, nose and whiskers with black marker.



8. Slip the book marker on the corner of a page to save your place in the book.
