



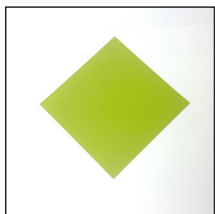
## FROG BOOKMARK

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 6-in. x 6-in. Green Cardstock
- 2-in x 4-in. Green Cardstock for eyelids
- 2-in. x 2-in. White Cardstock for eyes
- 1/2-in. x 2-in. Red Cardstock for tongue
- Black Fine Tip Sharpie Marker
- 1/4-in. Double Stick Tape
- Scissors
- Pencil/Pen - for tracing\*
- Quarter\*
- \*or use a 1-in. Circle Punch



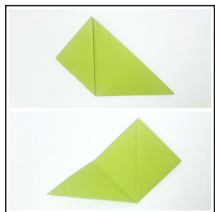
### INSTRUCTIONS



1. Place the 6-in. x 6-in. green cardstock turned on point like a diamond.



2. Fold the piece in half with the bottom point up to meet the top point, forming a triangle. Crease well.

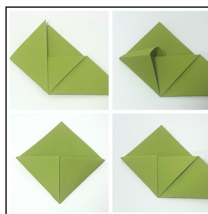


3. Fold the bottom left point upwards meeting the top point. Crease well. Unfold.

Fold the bottom right point upwards to meet the top point. Crease well. Unfold.



4. Take just the top layer of the top point and fold it down to the bottom edge. Crease well. It forms sort of a pocket.



5. Take the bottom left point and fold it back up. Now, tuck it into the pocket.

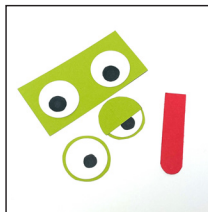
Do the same with the bottom right point.

Now you have the base corner bookmark.



6. Use a 1-in. circle punch or trace a quarter onto white cardstock and cut out to make two white circles for the eyes.

Use a black marker to draw two small circles onto the white circles to complete the eyes.



7. Tape the eyes onto green cardstock. Cut around the eyes leaving a small border of green. You can also add a piece over the eyes to make an eyelid.

Place an eye on either side of the pocket and tape in place.

Curve cut the corners off on one side of the red cardstock strip. Tape the other end from inside the pocket to make the tongue.



8. Use as a bookmark by tucking the pocket onto the corner of a page in a book.

You can also use this as an embellishment on a card. For a Vegas theme, you can tape some money coming out of the mouth for a fun card.
