HAPPI COAT/HAORI KIMONO ORIGAMI

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

1 qty. - 2 in. x 6 in. origami paper*

Optional for Kokeshi head:

- 1 qty. - 1 in. circle light cardstock for face
- 1 qty. - 2 in. x 2 in. black cardstock for hair
- Black Marker
- Pink Pencil for blush - optional
- 1/4 in. Double Stick tape (#30013284)
- Scissors

NOTE: You can use any size paper, but the dimensions need to be such that the longer length is 3 times the width.

Example: 4 in. wide x 12 in. long, 3 in. wide x 9 in. long.



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Fold the 2 in. x 6 in. paper into thirds, accordion style. Crease well.



2. With the section that has the paper design right side up, fold the edge over 1/4-inch to the back. NOTE: If using a different size of paper, this is equal to about 1/8 of the section.



3. Find the center point of this section. To do this, unfold the piece. Bring the sides of the section together, but do not crease the middle. Instead, just pinch the top edge to mark the center.



4. On this top section only, fold each corner to the center. Crease well. This will be the happi coat collar.



5. Take the sides, with all three-layers of thickness, and fold to the center stopping at the edge of the collar. Crease well.




6. Fold back open just the top layer of the sides. A small triangle will form at the top. Crease well.




7. Fold the top down to the back, leaving just the top point of the collar extended and revealing the top of the happi coat sleeves. Crease well.



8. Fold the bottom layer about two thirds up to the back to reveal the sleeves and complete the happi coat. Crease well.



Optional - create a kokeshi doll head and glue to the top of the happi coat. The sample used a 1 in. circle for the face for this small sized piece. Use your origami piece to decorate a card or tag. You can also add a pin to the back so you can wear it.
