



ORIGAMI KOKESHI DOLL POCKET


SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 6 in. x 6 in. printed origami/washi paper
- 3 in. x 3 in. cream colored cardstock for face
- 4 in. x 8 in. black cardstock for hair
- Black Marker
- Pink colored pencil for cheeks
- 1/4-in. double stick tape
- Scissors
- Punched flowers, stickers, ribbon, etc. for hair embellishments
- Tacky glue for embellishments
- Goodies to fill pocket

INSTRUCTIONS



1. With the paper on point, fold in half, bringing the bottom point to top point. Crease well.




2. Take the right-side point and bring across to the left side. Crease well. Take the left-side point and bring across to the right, aligning the straight edges. Crease well.



3.
 a) Take the top point and fold back to the left, folding it in half.
 b) Lift back to the center and open up.
 c) Flatten, aligning the top point with the center of the piece.
 d) Take the top point and tuck into the pocket



4. With the top point tucked into the pocket, flatten the center. If you want, you can tape down the center point inside the pocket to secure.



5. Trace and cut out the front and back hair patterns from the black cardstock.

Use a 2.5-inch circle punch or trace and cut out the face pattern from cream cardstock.



6. Tape the face behind the hair front.

Use a black marker to draw in dot eyes. Use the pink colored pencil to draw in cheeks.



7. Position the head above the top of the pocket. Tape in place.

Match up the hair back and tape together.




8. You can add other embellishments like a ribbon to the hair.

Fill the pocket with goodies or money.
 NOTE: The pocket is open on the bottom.
