



MONEY ORIGAMI FLOWER

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 3 - 4 Dollar Bills - clean and crispy
- Floral wire or chenille stem
- Bead for flower center - 10mm or larger

Optional - wire cutter




INSTRUCTIONS




1. With the face side up, fold the dollar bill in half. Crease well and unfold.

Fold each side to the center fold. Crease well.



2. Fold the piece in half, top to bottom. Crease well and unfold. You just want to have a middle crease line.

Fold each corner in, aligning with the new center crease line. Crease well.



3. With all 4 corners folded in, fold the top edge down to the center and crease well.

Fold the bottom edge up to the center and crease well.



4. Fold the piece up in half.

This makes one set of petals.

Repeat steps 1 through 4 with the other dollar bills. Make at least 3-4 petal sets.



5. Thread a bead to the center of the floral wire.

Gather the sets of petals and stack together with the open ends facing up. Sample is using 4 sets to make 8 petals.

Center the floral wire over the stack, with the bead on the center top. Twist the ends of the floral wire together to hold the petals in place.



6. Carefully place your finger in each petal pocket and open each petal up. Adjust the petals to shape the flower.



7. Adjust the petals to shape the flower.



8. You can use the flowers for gift toppers, centerpieces or add onto lei.
