# BEADED SHAMROCK

## SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 3 qty. 12-in. of 24 gauge beading wire #30085108
- Green Seed Beads Mix 6/0 #30217420 or smaller

### Jewelry tools:

- Flush Cutter
- Round Nose Plier

### Options:

- Pinback
- E-6000 glue
- Corsage Pin

**NOTE:** The sample used 30 seed beads per petal.  
You can also make 4 petals and make it a 4-Leaf Clover.



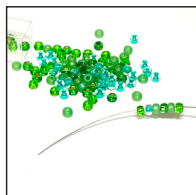
## INSTRUCTIONS



1. Take one 12-in. length of wire and bend one end up to prevent the beads from sliding off.



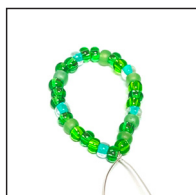
6. Grab the tip at the end of the twisted wires with the round nose pliers. Coil up the end so that the wires will not snag any clothing.



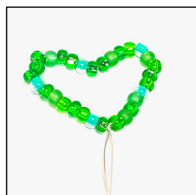
2. Thread 30 beads onto the wire.  
You can adjust the quantity based on the size of the beads and how large you want the finished piece.



7. To wear, glue on a pin back or use a long pin like a boutonniere.



3. Push all the beads to the center of the wire.  
Twist the ends of the wire together to hold the beads in place.



4. Gently push the center of the beads down towards the twisted end to shape into a heart.  
Round out the side curves of the heart.



5. Repeat steps 1 - 4 with the other two wires to make three beaded petals.  
Bunch the three hearts together and twist all the wires together down to the end.  
You can also make 4 petals and make it into a 4-Leaf Clover.
