



PANDA FAN

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Blank Fan Base #30139465
- Black Cardstock
- White Cardstock
- Pink Cardstock
- Black Marker
- White Decolor Marker - fine point
- Scissors
- 1/4 in. double stick tape #30013284
- Circle Paper Punches - 3-inch, 2-inch, 1-inch

Optional:

- 12 in. to 15 in. of ribbon for a bow

NOTE: When you purchase your cardstock at Ben Franklin Crafts, you can use the Accu Cut die cutting system to cut out shapes like the Fan Cover.

You can use paper punches for the circles pieces or you can trace similar sized objects like ribbon rolls and coins.



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Use the Accu Cut die for the Fan Cover and cut out one from white cardstock.



2. Trace and cut out pieces from black cardstock according to the patterns.

Use circle paper punches to cut out two 3 in. ears in black, two 2 in. eyes in white, two 2 in. cheeks in pink and two 1 in. eyes in black.



3. Place the two ears on the fan base along the upper edge. Tape in place.



4. Place the white fan cover on top, aligning with the fan edges. Tape in place for the panda's face.



5. Layer the 1 in. black circle on top of the white 2 in. circle for the eyes.

Place the eyes on the black eye pad piece and tape in place.



6. Place the pink cheeks slightly under the eye pads and tape in place.

Tape the eye pads in place.



7. Use the black marker to draw in a mouth below the nose.

Use the white marker to add highlight dots to the black eyes.



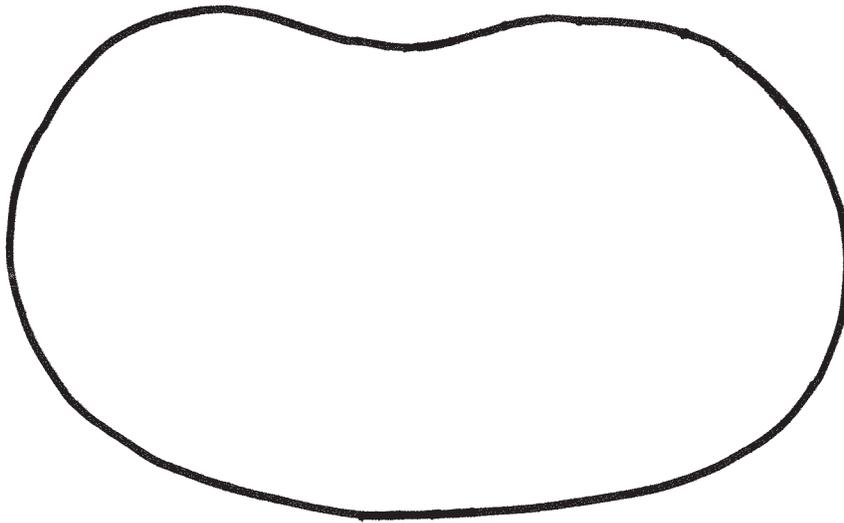
8. Optional - tie a ribbon bow to the handle of the fan.
