TUBULAR EASTER FAVOR

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 4½ in. Paper Tube - clean
- 4½ in. x 6 in. White Cardstock
- 1 in. x 2 in. Blue Cardstock - eyes
- 1 in. x 2 in. White Cardstock - eyes
- 1 in. x 1 in. Pink Cardstock - nose
- 12 in. x 12 in. White Tissue Paper
- 12 - 15 inches of ribbon
- ¾ in. Double-stick Tape
- Black Fine tip marker
- ¾ in. circle punch
- 5/8 in. circle punch
- Scissors
- Small wrapped candy

NOTE: In place of punches, you can trace a penny for a ¾ in. circle and a dime for a 5/8 in. circle.


INSTRUCTIONS



1. Tape on end of the white cardstock to the tube, aligning the edges.




2. Wrap the white cardstock around the tube. Overlap the end and tape down



3. Cut two ¾ in. circles from blue cardstock. Cut two 5/8 in. circles from white cardstock. Layer the white circle on top of the blue circles, slightly offset. Use the black marker to draw whiskers on the sides of the nose. Tape the eyes to the wrapped tube.



4. Cut a small heart from the pink cardstock and glue below the eyes for a nose. Use the black marker to draw whiskers on the sides of the nose.



5. Place tissue paper on point, like a diamond. Place 4-6 wrapped candy in the center of the tissue paper, leaving a 1-inch space in the center.



6. Roll the tissue paper up with the candy inside.



7. Bring the two ends of the rolled tissue paper together, folding at the center space. Tie a ribbon at the top of where the candy ends. Separate the tissue ends and shape into bunny ears.



8. Place the tissue paper bundle into the bunny tube with the ears coming out from the top.
