MONEY ORIGAMI FROG


SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 1 Dollar Bill - clean and crispy

Optional Extras - Clear Plastic Lei Tubing for Lei



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Fold the dollar bill in half lengthwise with the face side on the inside. Crease well and unfold. Take the top corners of each side and fold down aligning the top edge with the center fold line. Crease well and unfold.

Take the bottom corners and fold up aligning the bottom edge with the center fold line. Crease well and unfold.



2. Using the new "X" creased lines, push in the sides and to form a triangle and flatten. Do this on both sides.



3. Fold up the edge of the dollar bill at the center on both sides.



4. Flip the piece over. On both sides, fold just the top layer to the center. Crease well and unfold.

Fold the top point down. Crease well.



5. Slightly open the "pockets" on each side of the top point.



6. Fold the sides back in but tuck in the tops into the pockets.



7. Flip the piece over.

Lift the four ends and fold at an angle to form the frog's legs.



8. Flip the piece over and you have your frog. You can test how the frog leaps by pressing down on the back triangle and releasing. The frog should hop.

Do not press down too hard or you might make your frog flip over! You can use your frog to add as a decoration. Or add on a pinback and wear as a pin. You can use the frogs for lei by inserting in to clear plastic tubing.
