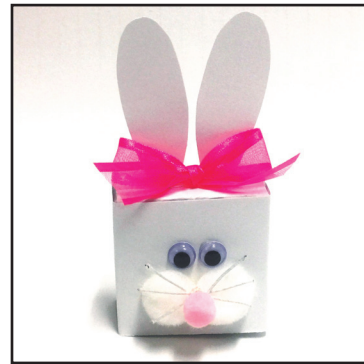
## EZ ORIGAMI BUNNY

### SUPPLIES

- 6 in. x 6 in. Cardstock for box
- 2 1/8 in. x 7 1/2 in. Cardstock for Sleeve Cover
- 3 in. x 3 in. Cardstock for ears
- 2 qty. 10mm Moving Eyes
- 2 qty. 3/4 in. White Pom Poms for cheeks
- 1/4 in. Pink Pom Pom for nose
- 4 1/2 in. of White cloth Covered wire or string for whiskers
- 9 in. of 5/8 in. ribbon for bow
- 1/4 in. Meriken Double Stick Tape

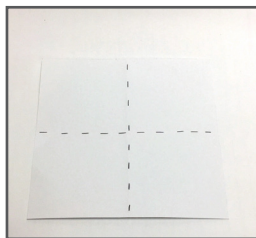
### TOOLS

- Scissors
- Low temp Glue Gun & Glue sticks

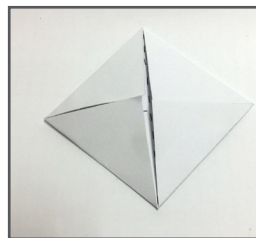


### INSTRUCTIONS

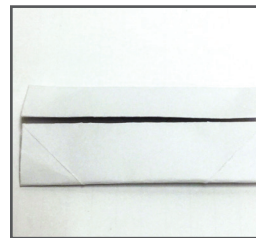
Patterns on back of sheet.



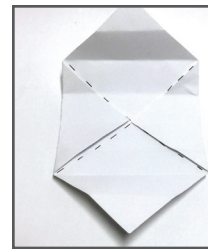
1. Fold the cardstock in half vertically then horizontally to create 4 squares. (dotted lines show creased lines)



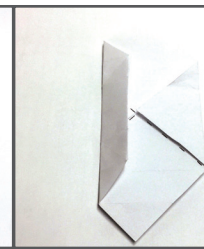
2. Fold in the all 4 corners to the center of the cardstock. Crease well.



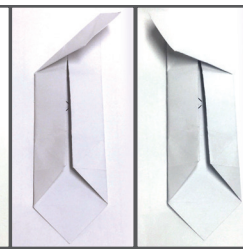
3. Turn the paper so it is a square in front of you. Fold the top edge down to the center. Crease well. Fold the bottom edge up to the center. Crease well.



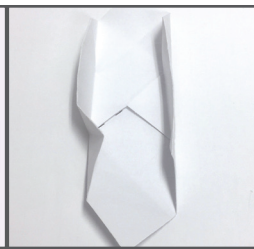
4. Unfold, leaving just the two side triangle folds in place.



5. Fold in the left side to the center point and crease well. Fold in the right side the same way and crease well.



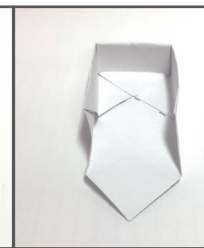
6. Fold down the top left corner, going along the angled edge. Crease well and unfold. Repeat with the top right corner. Repeat the steps with the two bottom corners.



7. Lift the sides to start forming the box (The dotted lines show the creased lines that were formed in step 5.)



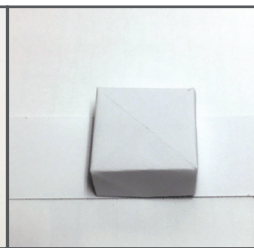
8. Fold the top of the piece over into the box to form another side.



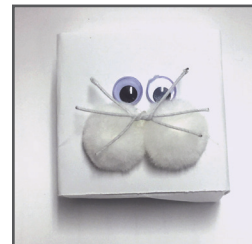
9. Fold the point flat at the bottom, meeting up in the center with the other two points.



10. Repeat with the opposite side of the box to complete the box.



11. To make the Sleeve - Take box and place it upside down on the 2 1/8 in. x 7 1/2 in. strip of cardstock. Wrap the cardstock around the box overlapping the ends. Finger crease the edges around the box for a nice fit. Tape the ends together at the overlap.



12. Turn the box over. Place the eyes and pom-poms onto the sleeve cover to make the bunny face and glue in place. Snip the wire into three 1 1/2 in. lengths and twist together in the middle for the whiskers. Place in the middle of the pom-poms and glue in place. Glue the pink pom-pom on top for the nose.



13. Fold the 3 in. x 3 in. cardstock in half. Through both thicknesses, cut out an elongated leaf shape for the ears. Turn the box on its side. Tape or glue the ears to the box.



14) Tie a bow with the ribbon and glue in front of the ears. Slide the box open and fill with treats.
