- 8.5-in. x 11-in. Med. Vellum #30168934 - ears
- 2-in. x 4-in. Blue Cardstock - eyes
- 2-in. x 4-in. White Cardstock - eyes
- 1.5-in. x 2.5-in. Black cardstock - eyes
- 1.5-in. x 1.5-in. Pink cardstock - nose
- 2 qty. 1.5-in. x 5-in. Pink cardstock - inner ears
- 4 qty. 1/4-in. x 2.5-in. White Cardstock - whiskers
- 2 qty. 1/4-in. x 2-in. White Cardstock - whiskers
- 4 qty. White Chenille Stems #77677382- ears
- 1.5-in. Circle Punch #30028731
- 1-in. Circle Punch #30028719
- 3/16-in. Double Stick Tape #30018283
- 1/4-in. Double Stick Tape #30013284
- White Posca Paint Marker #30187986
- Glue Gun and glue sticks
- Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS



1. Make sure the glass block is clean and dry before starting.

Place the 3/16-in. double stick tape along the edge of the 7-in x 7-in. vellum.

Place the glass block so that the opening is at the top.

Center the vellum to the front of the block and tape down.



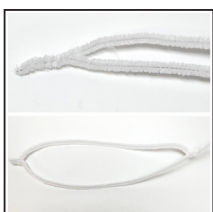
2. With the 1 1/2-in. circle punch, punch out two circles from white cardstock and two from blue cardstock.

With the 1-in. circle punch, punch out one circle from pink cardstock and two from black cardstock.



3. **Eyes** - Layer a white circle onto a blue circle a little offset and tape together. Tape a black circle onto the white circle. Use the white paint marker to make a dot on the black for an accent. Repeat for the other eye.

Use the photo as a guide and tape the eyes, nose and whisker strips to the vellum for the bunny's face.



4. Take two white chenille stems and twist together at one end. Fold the tip down. This will be the top of the bunny ears. Take the other two ends and twist together. Shape into ears.

Repeat with the other two chenille stems.



5. Cut the 8.5-in. x 11-in. vellum in half lengthwise.

Glue each chenille stem shaped ear onto a piece of vellum. Trim off excess vellum, using the chenille stem as a guide.

Cut two inner ears from pink cardstock and tape to the lower center of the ears.



6. Glue the bottom ends of the ears to the glass block opening.

Add greenery and flowers along the top of the block to embellish the bunny. You can also glue the ears to the greenery instead of directly on the block.



7. Add firefly lights through the glass block opening to illuminate the bunny.
