



PAPER PENCIL GIFT CARD HOLDER


SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 3 in. x 3 in. Cardstock - Yellow Beige - #30245651 - pencil tip
- 4 in. x 10-1/2 in. Cardstock - Bright Yellow - #30245596 - pencil
- 1/2 in. x 8 in. Cardstock - Medium Grey - #30245661 - metal band
- 1-1/2 in. x 3 in. Cardstock - Baby Pink - #30245611 - eraser


- Score Board
- Scissors
- Double stick tape
- Black Marker - pencil lead
- Optional - Ribbon and tag



INSTRUCTIONS




1. Take the 4 in. x 10-1/2 in. yellow cardstock and place lengthwise along the top edge of the Score Board. Score at the following inches: 1-1/2, 4-1/2 and 7-1/2




2. Take the yellow scored piece. Fold over the 1-1/2 in. scored line.

Tape up the edges to make the gift card pocket.




3. Trace and cut out the pencil point piece from the beige cardstock.

Use the black marker to color in the tip to look like pencil lead.



4. Trace and cut out the eraser and metal band pieces from the pink and grey cardstocks



5. On the middle section of the yellow piece, position and tape in place the pink eraser on the right side, as shown.

With the colored lead side down, position and tape the pencil tip on the left side of the middle section.



6. On the top section, put tape all around the edges.

Fold over and tape to the center section, sandwiching the eraser and pencil tip.



7. Place gift card in the pocket.

Fold the gift card holder closed.



8. Wrap the grey band around the end by the pink eraser to hold it closed. Overlap the ends on the back and tape together.

You can tie a ribbon bow on the other side for a more secure closure. Add a tag with punny sentiment like "Mahalo for teaching me the WRITE stuff"
