



EASTER EGG HOLDER

MATERIALS & TOOLS

- Qty. 1 - 1" x 8 1/2" Green Cardstock - inner circle to hold the egg
- Qty. 3 - 2" x 8 1/2" Green Cardstock (two shades if possible)
- 2" x 3" Cardstock for each Bunny (White Gray/Brown)
- 1/4" Double stick tape #30013284
- Easter Egg - plastic or real
- Score Board #30195075
- Scissors
- Markers/Colored Pencils for bunny details
- **Optional** - flower/butterfly stickers for embellishment



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Wrap the 1" x 8 1/2" green cardstock into a loop and rest the egg on top. Adjust the length as needed. Overlap at least 1/2" and tape together, trim off excess as needed.

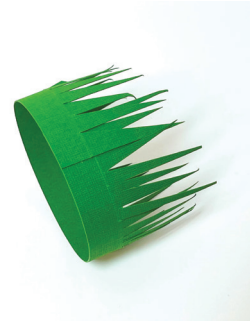


2. Take one of the 2" x 8 1/2" green cardstocks that you want as the inner core if you are using more than one shade of green. Score at 1" the 8 1/2" length. Take the other green cardstock and score the 8 1/2" length at 1/2".



3. Snip each strip to the scored line. Snip at different angles to create a grass effect.

INSTRUCTIONS (Continued)



4. Take the 1" scored piece and wrap into a loop. Overlap the ends by 1/2" and tape together.



5. Take the 1/2" scored line piece and wrap around the first loop. Overlap the ends and tape together.



6. Place the egg holder piece inside and tape to just one side.



7. **Optional:** Add another layer of grass if you want a fuller look.



8. Cut out bunny shapes. Draw face details with markers or pencils.



9. Place bunnies in between the grass layers, tape down if needed.
