



# LEI GO BRICKS FLOWER BRACELET

## SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 24 pcs. Brick Flower Base - Pink #30254212
- 12 pcs. Brick Leaves - Apple Green #30254183
- 40 pcs. Brick Flower Clover - White #3054174
- Elasticity Stretch cord .8mm Clear #30061094
- Wire Cutters or similar
- Craft & Upholstery Needle = large eye 6 in. #30253951
- Scissors
- Low Temp Glue Gun & Glue Sticks

NOTE: Because this bracelet uses stretchy elastic cord, the flower bricks can separate as the bracelet stretches. Adding a small bit of glue helps to keep them together.

Adjust flower quantity and cord length as needed to fit your wrist.



## INSTRUCTIONS



1. Optional - Prep Beads:  
Put a dot of glue on the inside of one of the pink flower bricks. Quickly, join the other pink brick to make one flower bead.


Do this with all 24 bricks to make 12 flower beads.



2. Cut 12 inches of Elasticity cord. String on one flower bead then one leaf brick. Continue with all 12 flowers and leaves.



3. To tie the stretchy cord together, take the two ends and wind one side around the other twice.  
Bring the ends together and tie at least two knots. Pull and stretch cord to make sure the knots are secure.  
Trim excess cord off and tuck knot into the hole of the bead.



4. Prep Clover flower -  
Take each of the flower bricks and cut off about half of the stem length.  
When you cut the stem, it may make the stem compress the hole. Stick the tip of the big needle into the compressed stem to open the hole again.

Do this for all 40 Clover Flower bricks.



5. Cut a 12-inch length of the Elasticity cord.

String on all 40 Clover Flowers.



6. Take the strand of Clover flowers and wrap/twist around the pink flower bracelet. Tie the ends of the cord together like in step 3.  
Pull and stretch cord to make sure the knots are secure.  
Trim excess cord off and tuck knot into the hole of the bead.
