



# UNICORN POM POM

## SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- White Yarn #77640573- unicorn head
- 2 qty. - 1 -in. x 2 -in. White Felt #77676635 - ears
- 4-in. x 4-in. White Felt #77676635 - horn
- Metallic Cord in iridescent #30218162, silver or gold to wrap the horn
- 1 - in. x 3 - in. Black Cardstock or Foamie - eyelashes
- Small flowers and leaves #30225717
- Pom Pom Maker Tool \*- large or cardboard
- Sharp Scissors
- Low-temp Glue Gun & Glue Sticks
- Pencil/pen for tracing
- Ruler

**NOTE:** If you don't have a pom pom maker, wrap yarn around a sturdy 6 - inch cardboard to make your pom pom.



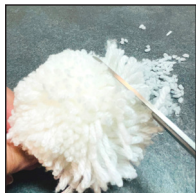
## INSTRUCTIONS



1. Make a large pom pom out of the white yarn. The sample shown is approx. 2.5-inches.

You can use a pom pom maker tool, which will use less yarn.

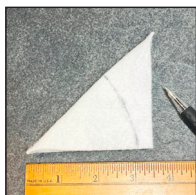
Or, wrap yarn around a sturdy piece of cardboard. The sample used 6-inch cardboard and the yarn was wrapped around 250 times to make a full pom pom.



2. Use the cording to tie up the yarn bundle, leaving a long enough tail to use as a hanger. Trim yarn bundle to make your pom pom. Set the pom pom aside for now.



3. For the Unicorn Horn - Fold the top edge over to the side edge, creating a triangle.



4. Measure 3 inches along the fold and bottom straight edge. Cut at the marked line



5. Open the felt. Glue the end of the metallic cord to the felt, coming out at the top point.



6. Starting from one straight edge, roll across to the other edge forming a cone.

Glue the end of the wrap down.



7. Take the metallic cording and slowly spiral wrap around the cone. Spot glue as needed.



8. Glue the end of the cording to the inside.

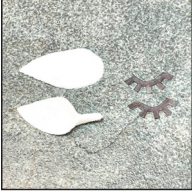


9. Take the pom pom and separate some of the yarn near the base of the hanger cord. Place the horn in that spot. Add glue to secure the horn to the pom pom.





## INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED



10. Cut two 1.5-inch leaf shapes from the white felt for the ears.

For the eyes, cut two half inch-long semi circles with points from black cardstock for the eyelashes. Or, you can just do round circles or use moving eyes.

Glue eyes to the pom pom front, about halfway down from the horn.



11. Glue an ear to either side of the horn.

Glue eyes to the pom pom front, about halfway down from the horn.



12. Place flowers and leaves around the horn at the top of the head. Glue in place.

Tie the ends of the cording together for a hanger.
