PAPER TREAT BAG FISH FAVOR

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Paper Sack Gift Bag
- Curling Ribbon
- 1-in. x 2-in. white cardstock - eyes
- Black Sharpie marker #91029
- Glue Dots #30001508
- Double-stick Tape #30013284
- 1-in. Circle Punch #30028719 or quarter to trace
- Scissors
- Wrapped Candy/Treats

INSTRUCTIONS



1. On the open end of the bag, fold in each corner, leaving about 1-3/4 inches in between along the open edge. Crease well.



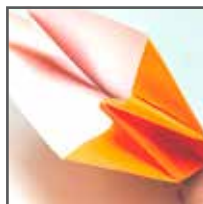
3. Flatten out the bag. From the bottom of the bag, using a half inch fold, accordion fold about 4-5 times.



5. Tie up the center with curling ribbon. Curl ribbon ends. Separate the folds to create the fish tail.



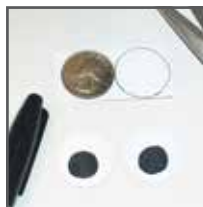
7. Glue an eye onto each side of the fish. Through the opening, puff up the bag to help shape the fish's body. Fill fish with treats. You can tape the mouth closed if you want.



2. Unfold the corners. Tuck in the corners to the sides of the bag using the crease lines. You can tape the tucks together to hold the shape. This will form the fish face/mouth.



4. Gather the bag where the accordion folds end, carefully "scrunching" the sides in. Pinch the center and fold up both sides of the accordion to meet in the center.



6. Use a 1-in. circle punch or trace a quarter to cut out two circles from the white cardstock. Use the black marker to draw in the eyes on the white circles.



8. Completed Fish Favor. Optional - you can use paper scraps and cut out fins to add to the side of the bodies if you want.
