



## UPCYCLED NORI CONTAINERS

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Nori Container – cleaned and dry
- Washi Tape and/or Printed Cardstock – assorted
- Ribbons – 3/8” to 5/8” width, approx. 10” long
- 1/4” Meriken Double Stick Tape #30013284
- 1/4” Hole Punch #77178558
- Scissors
- Tissue paper or paper shreds to line the basket
- Treats to put in the basket



### INSTRUCTIONS



1. Wash and dry an empty seasoned nori container. Wrap container with washi tape as desired.



5. Use the 1/4” hole punch to make two holes at the top on each side.



2. Using a 1/4” hole punch, make a hole on both sides, in the center just below the container lip.



6. Take two lengths of ribbon. Thread the ribbon through the holes on both sides and tie a bow on the outside of the container.



3. Thread about 8”-10” of ribbon through the holes. Start from the inside of the container and pull the ribbon out, leaving the ends of the ribbon on the inside. Knot the ends of the ribbon to create the basket handle.



7. Line the basket with paper shreds or tissue paper and add treats.



4. Another way to decorate the container is to wrap the container with scrap printed paper. Place a strip of double stick tape about 1/4” below the paper edge. Tape the paper to the outside of the container on both sides.
