



RIBBON TURTLE

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 2 pieces - 42 in. long - 3/8 in. Satin Ribbon in two shades of green for the shell
- 6 pieces - 3 in. long - 5/8 in. Satin Ribbon - green or brown for head and feet
- Low temp Glue Gun & glue sticks
- Scissors
- Optional - 7mm moving eyes

NOTE: You can change the size of the ribbon to change the size of your turtle.

INSTRUCTIONS



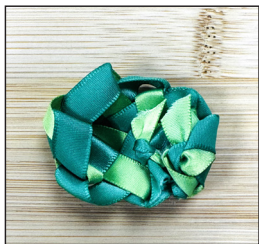
1. Take the two green ribbons and weave like a single braided lei about 6 in. long.

If you are not sure how to weave the ribbon lei, you can find instructions at benfranklinhawaii.com under project sheets "Braided Ribbon Lei".



2. Wrap the lei length into a circle, overlapping the ends.

Glue the overlap together.



3. Trim off the excess ribbon ends. Tuck the ends under and glue in place. This makes the shell.



4. Take one of the 5/8 in. ribbon piece and fold in half without creasing. This will be the turtle's head.



5. Glue the ends of the ribbon for the head under the shell, with just the head peeking out.

Optional - you can glue on small moving eyes if you want.



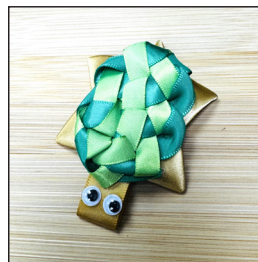
6. Take one of the 5/8 in. ribbons and cross over the ends to make a small cone on the middle. Spot glue to hold the ribbon together. Trim off the excess ends of the ribbon.

Glue to the opposite side of the shell from the head.
This is the turtle's tail.



7. Take the remaining four pieces 5/8 in. pieces and cross over the ends to make a small cone in the center. Make these cones a little larger than the tail.

Spot glue to hold the ribbon in place. Cut off the excess ribbon ends. Place around the shell for the feet and glue in place.



8. Add a pin back and wear as a pin.

You can use your turtle to embellish a card or lei.
