



POCKET LETTERS

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 1 qty. - 9-pocket Trading Card Holders #30256593
- 9 qty. - 2.5 in. x 3.5 in. decorated cardstock pieces
- Assorted treats like tea bags, stickers, candy, cookies, patches, etc.
- Scissors
- Ribbon
- Double stick tape
- Paper Trimmer



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Gather scrapbook papers in a matching theme or colorway. Or you can do completely unmatched design.



2. Trim pieces to a 2.5 in. x 3.5 in. size to fit the pockets.



3. Lay out the cards on top of the sheet protector to figure out your design.



4. Slip pieces into the pockets.



5. Add your treats in the pockets behind the pieces. You can add a folded letter in a pocket as well.

Note - Try to space out the bulky items so that it is more even when you fold the sheet protector in thirds.



6. Fold the sheet protector into thirds.

Slip a piece of ribbon through the binder ring holes to keep the piece folded together. Tie into a bow.

If it is flat enough, you can slip the Pocket Letter into a #10 envelope.
