DONUT BESTIE CARD

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 5 in. x 7 in. blank card base
- 4.75 in. x 6.75 in. cardstock for mat on front of card base
- 2 qty. - 2.5 in. cardstock circles - donut colors
- 2 qty. - 2.5 in. cardstock circles - frosting colors
- Embellishments for donuts - beads, sprinkles, glitter, etc.
- Alphabet stickers, stamps or marker for writing sentiment
- Tacky Glue or similar
- 1/4 in. Double Stick Tape
- Pencil for tracing
- Scissors
- Nickel or similar for tracing middle hole
- Optional - 4 qty. 12mm Moving Eyes

NOTE: You can print out a 2.5 in. circle to use as a pattern or use a die to cut out the donut pieces.



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Cut out two 2.5 in. circles from cardstock in the color you want for your donuts.



2. For the frosting, cut out two 2.5 in. circles from cardstock, either printed or solid.

Draw a wavy line along the inside border. Cut out for the frosting.

Center on the donut base and glue.



3. Turn the donut piece over. Place a nickel in the center and trace around it.

Carefully cut out this inner circle to make the donut hole. You will be cutting through two thicknesses of cardstock.



4. Decorate donuts - You can add "sprinkles" by gluing on small beads or bits onto the frosting.



5. Place donuts on the card front. Leave space for the wording.

Glue down donuts.

Add a sentiment like "Donut forget UR my Bestie!" using alphabet stickers or stamps and/or just hand letter with a marker.



6. Place the moving eyes on the donuts and glue down.
