





## **EZ ORIGAMI ENVELOPE**

INSTRUCTIONS

## **SUPPLIES & TOOLS**

• 12-in. x 12-in. Paper or cardstock\*

• Optional – Paper Creaser

## NOTE:

Any size square paper can be used. The size of the paper will determine the finished envelope size. 12-in. x 12-in was used to create an envelope large enough for a gift card.

Using cardstock will be a little harder to fold because of the thickness of the paper. Using a paper creaser may help to get sharper creases.






1. Fold the square paper diagonally in half. This forms a triangle. Crease well.



2. With the fold on the bottom, fold down the point of the top layer to the fold. Crease well.



5. Now take the left point and fold it back to the left side, forming a small triangle pocket. Crease well.



6. Open the top layer of the small triangle pocket and squash fold down. This will form a small diamond square in the center at the bottom edge.



3. Take the point on the bottom right side and fold across the bottom, about two thirds to the left. Crease well.



4. Take the bottom left point and fold across to the right meeting the right edge. Crease well.



7. Take the top point and fold down and slip inside edge the square diamond pocket to close the envelope.



8. You can leave the envelope as is and enjoy the simplicity of the design. Or, you can add extra embellishments as you desire.

This size envelope you can use for a gift card or money gift. Using smaller 6-in. x 6-in. origami paper is great for small gifts or even as seed packets to share seeds with friends.
