



EZ PAPER BASKET

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 12-in. x 12-in. Cardstock*
- 1/4-in. Double stick tape #30013284 or Tacky Glue #1360916
- Score Board #30193342
- Scissors

NOTE: If you do not want a handle on your basket, you will just need an 8.5-in x 11-in. cardstock.



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Cut an 8.5-in. x 11-in. piece from the 12-in. x 12-in. cardstock.

Save the remaining cardstock on the side if you want to make a handle later.



5. Lift up all 4 sides surrounding the center section. Angle the sides inward and slide the folded edges over the middle section on each side.

Glue the small flaps to the middle section, slightly overlapping the corners.



2. Place the cardstock on the score board with the right side up and the 11-in. edge along the top. Score at the following points: 4-inch and 7-inch.

Turn the cardstock so that the 8.5-in edge is along the top of the score board. Score at the following points: 2.5-inch and 6-inch.



6. Fold the top corner points down over the edge of the basket. Glue or tape to the inside of the basket.



3. There should be 9 sections with a 3-in. x 3.5-in. section in the center.

Fold in all of the scored lines and crease well. Unfold.

With the cardstock laying landscape, cut the vertical scored lines at the top and bottom sections, stopping at the center intersecting points in the middle.



7. Your basket is done and you can fill it with goodies.

If you want to add a handle to the basket, take the leftover cardstock and cut a 1-in. x 12-in. strip. Center the strip over the basket. Glue the ends to the inside of the basket



4. Fold in both the left and right edges to the edge of the center section. The result will have the outer sections folded in half. Crease well.
