



GIFT CARD ALBUM

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 5 qty. of 3 in. x 8 in. cardstock for base pages*
- 5 qty. of 2 in. x 9 in. cardstock for pockets*
- 2 qty. of 3 in. x 4 in. cardstock for covers
- Scoreboard
- Scissors
- 1/4 in. double stick tape #30013284
- 2-1/2 in. x 3 in. Fabric scraps or similar for album spine*
- Tacky Glue
- Elastic or ribbon to tie around album to keep closed
- Scraps of ribbon, yarn to tie on to the elastic for decoration

Optional:

- Embellishments like stickers, stamps, die cuts, etc.
- Marker for writing messages and quotes

NOTE: You can make as many pages as you want, sample has five pages. If you make more pages, you will need to adjust the size of the fabric used for the spine and the length of the elastic/ribbon closure.



INSTRUCTIONS

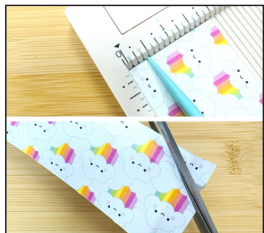


1. Take the 3 in. x 8 in. cardstocks for the base pages and place the 8 in. edge along the top of the score board. Score at the 4 in. center mark for each page.



2. Take the 2 in. x 9 in. cardstocks for the pockets and place on the score board with the 9 inch length along the top. Score at:

1/2 in., 4-1/2 in. and 8-1/2 in.



3. Turn the cardstock so that the 2 in. edge is along the top of the score board. Score at 1/2 in. the entire length.
 NOTE: For the pockets, if the cardstock has a one direction design, make sure you score the 1/2 in. at the bottom edge. Trim pocket corners at an angle to create less bulk.



4. Place double stick tape on the 1/2 in. tabs of the pockets. On the other side, place tape along the center crease line of the pockets. Place the pockets onto the base pages, matching up the two center crease lines. Tape the pockets down next to the center crease.



5. Fold the tabs under and tape to the back of the pages, aligning the fold with the bottom and side edges.

Repeat steps to make all the pocket page sets.



6. Fold the pages closed and stack in the order you want for the album.

Tape/glue each page set to the next to form the album.



7. Glue a 3 in. x 4 in. cover to the front and back. Cut or tear a piece of fabric 3 in. tall and wide enough to wrap around the spine with about a 1 in. overlap on both the front and back covers. Use liquid glue-like Tacky glue to glue the fabric to the front and back covers. Let dry.



8. Finishing - Add a closure by tying a piece of elastic or ribbon to wrap around and hold the album closed. You can tie bits of ribbon and yarn onto the elastic to decorate. You can also add stickers or die cuts to the pockets and pages. Or write messages and/or quotes, too. Fill pockets with gift cards and or cash.
