

## MINI STAR BOOK

## SUPPLIES \& TOOLS

- 5 qty. $-5-\mathrm{in} . \times 12$-in. Cardstock $A$ (center)
- 5 qty. $-5-\mathrm{in} . \times 10-\mathrm{in}$. Cardstock B (middle)
- 5 qty. -5 -in. $\times 8.5$-in. Cardstock C (outer page)
- 2 qty. $-5-\mathrm{in} . \times 6$-in. Chipboard or similar for book covers
- 2 qty. -6 -in. $\times 7$-in. Cardstock to cover covers
- 2 qty. - 24-inch lengths of ribbon for closures/hanger
- 1/4-in. Double stick tape \#30013284 or other adhesives
- Score Board \#30193342
- Scissors
- Paper Trimmer \#30174692

Optional:

- Paper Creaser \#30003774
- Stickers, Die cuts, tags, etc. for embellishments


INSTRUCTIONS


1. Place each of the cardstocks $A, B$ and $C$ on the score board right side up and with the long edge along the top. Score down the middle of each: Cardstock A at 6-inch mark
Cardstock B at the 5-inch mark
Cardstock $C$ at the 4.25 -inch mark
Fold at the scored line and crease well.

2. Take one of the folded Large cardstock pieces (A $5 \times 12$ ) and place double stick tape vertically along the inside 5 -inch edges.

Take one of the folded Medium Cardstock pieces (B $5 \times 10$ ) and place double stick tape vertically along the inside 5-inch edges.

Place the folded Medium cardstock piece (B $5 \times 10$ ) in front of the Large piece. Match up the 5 -inch edges and tape together. There will be a slight space gap at the center between the two pieces.

3. Now, take a folded Small cardstock piece (C $5 \times 8.5$ ) and line up in front of the Medium piece. Match up the 5 -inch edges on the sides and tape together.

Repeat steps 2 and 3 until all five sets are taped together.

4. Take one set and fold it closed so it is flat. Place double stick tape along all four edges and the center on the side facing up.

6. To make the book covers-

Place the 6-in. x 7-in. cardstocks in front of you with the wrong side up. Center the chipboard pieces on top. Fold over the cardstock edges onto the chipboard and tape in place.

Lay a ribbon length across each piece in the center with a loose end coming out over the 5 -inch edges. Tape the ribbon to the chipboard to hold in place.
7. With the loose ribbon ends hanging outwards, tape the ends of the book to the covers, matching up the edges.
5. Carefully, align another set on top and tape together.

Repeat until all five sets are joined end to end to make the book.

Place double stick tape around the edges and in the center of both ends of the book.
8. To form the star shape, place the covers back to back and tie the ribbon together to hold in place.

You can hang the star up or lay it down.
Use it as a scrapbook or journal by adding photos and writing on the pages or adding other embellishments.
