



SHAVE ICE MAGNET

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 2 in. circle watercolor paper
- Watercolor Paints
- Small Paintbrush
- Small cup of water
- 2 in. x 2.5 in. White cardstock
- Mini wood craft stick
- Bamboo Skewer
- White Acrylic Paint
- Wooden spring closure clothespin
- Button Magnet
- E-6000 glue
- 1/4 in. Double Stick Tape
- Scissors
- Low Temp Glue Gun & Glue Sticks
- Kitchen scissors or similar to cut the craft stick and bamboo skewer



INSTRUCTIONS

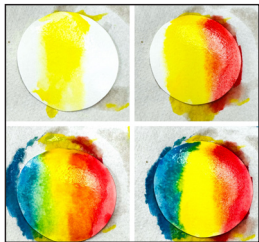


1. Use the E-6000 glue to glue the button magnet onto the wooden clothespin. Set aside.

NOTE: Use the E-6000 in a well-ventilated area and this should be handled by adults if working with children.



5. Cut about 1-inch off from the end of the bamboo skewer. Paint it with the white acrylic paint. Let dry.



2. Paint the watercolor circle with the watercolor paints. Give the circle a light coat of water to make the paints flow. To make Rainbow Shave Ice, paint yellow in the middle. Then Red on one side and Blue on the other side and let them flow into the yellow. You can enhance with orange and green paint in between. Let dry.

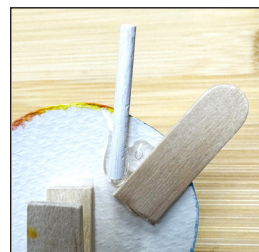


6. Cut the mini craft stick in half.



3. Trace and cut out the triangle from the white cardstock for the shave ice cone.

Tape to the bottom of the wooden clothespin.



7. Place the half mini craft stick behind the shave ice for the "spoon" and the painted bamboo skewer for the "straw". Glue in place with the glue gun.



4. Tape the watercolored circle for the shave ice onto the clothespin above the white "cone"

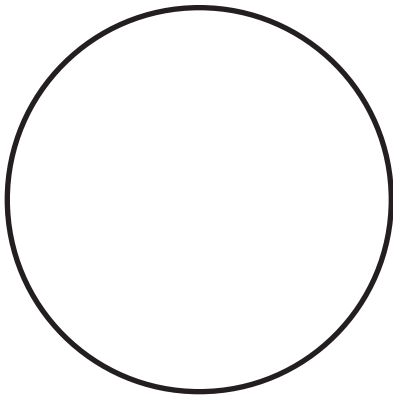


8. Finished. You can use to clip a photo or notes.



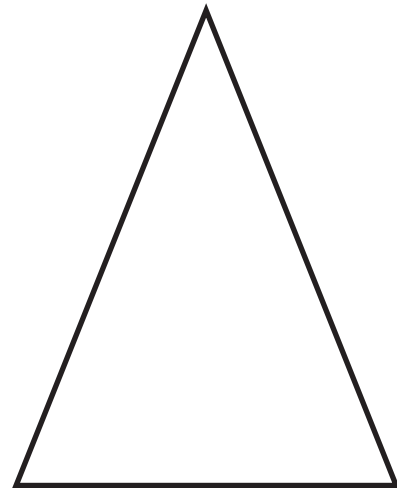


SHAVE ICE MAGNET - PATTERNS
