## **MINI BOOK**

## **SUPPLIES & TOOLS**

- 12-in. x 12-in. Cardstock solid or printed\*
- Score Board
- Paper Trimmer
- Scissors
- Embellishments for the pages and cover
- Double Stick Tape

NOTE: If you are using a printed cardstock, an all-over or non-directional design will work best since the cardstock will be turned and flipped.





## **INSTRUCTIONS**




1. Place the 12-in. x 12-in. cardstock onto the score board and score at the following points: 3-inch, 6-inch and 9-inch

You have divided the cardstock into 4 equal vertical sections.



5a. Flip up the folded sections with section 9 going onto section 5.

5b. Accordion fold sections 6 to 8, folding to the



2. Turn the cardstock a quarter turn and now score at the following points: 4-inch and 8-inch.

Now, the cardstock has 12 equal sections.

Fold all the crease lines.



6a. Flip up folded sections with section 8 going onto section 4.

6b. Accordion fold section 4 to 1, folding to the left.



3. Use the paper trimmer or scissors to make two slits.

The first slit is cut along the bottom of section 1 to section 3 (photo shows sections numbered for reference)

The second slit is cut along the top of sections 10 to section 12.





7. Decorate the mini book. You can embellish the pages and covers however you want. You can also use both sides of the book for even more pages.

For some of the doubled up pages, you can tape up the sides and used them as pockets.
