



ARTWORK CLIP

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Wood Coaster
- Wooden Clothespins
- E-6000 Glue or similar
- Acrylic Paints
- Mod Podge
- Clear Varnish Sealer
- Patterned Paper
- Paint Markers or Sharpies
- Embellishments – stickers, cut-outs, flowers, buttons, etc.
- Extra strong magnets
- Scissors
- Paint brushes
- Pencil for tracing



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Base – Cover the coaster with paint or paper.
NOTE: If you want to hang this up and your piece does not have pre-drilled holes, drill holes now.

Paint – Brush on acrylic paint and let dry.

Paper – Place the paper with the right side down. Place the wood coaster on top and trace around the piece using a pencil. Cut out and place on top of the coaster with the right side up. Tape/glue in place.



2. Personalize – Use a paint marker to add a name or saying. Let dry.



3. Seal – You can add a coat of clear varnish sealer now if you want or when you complete your design.



4. Embellish – Add more layers of papers, stickers, and other embellishments as you like. You can also add more dimensional embellishments, too.



5. Add Clips and Magnets – Position one or two wooden clothespins to the back of the coaster. Have the clip openings close to the edge.

Use a strong glue like E-6000 to glue on the clips.

Glue on magnets to the clips if you want.

Hanger – If your piece has holes, thread some ribbon or cord through and tie knots at the back to create a hanger.



6. Display – Display your piece on the fridge or wall.

Clip on artwork, notes, or photos to display.
