



ONE DIE TWO CARDS TECHNIQUE

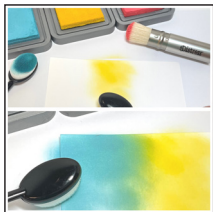
- LF Sending Big Hugs die #30228148
- 5.25-in. x 4-in. Smooth White Cardstock for front of card
- 2 qty - 5.5-in. x 4.25-in Card base #30236581
- Distress Oxide Ink Pad -(Blue) Broken China #30210984
- Distress Oxide Ink Pad - (Yellow) Mustard Seed #30222656
- Distress Oxide Ink Pad - (Red) Barn Door #30222647
- TH Retractable Blending Brush #30235625 or
- Hero Arts Ink Blending Brush - Medium #30236382
- 1/4-in Double Stick Tape #30013284
- Tacky Glue #1360916
- Embellishments - Stamped images, Jewelz, Doo Dadz, etc.
- LF Happy Hugs clear stamp set #30220948

- Big Shot, Gemini Jr. or other die cutting machine

INSTRUCTIONS



1. Take the 5.25x4 card front cardstock piece and place on a piece of scratch paper.

Use blending brushes to ink blend color onto the cardstock, one color at a time. Always start your blending off the edge of the card on the scratch paper and then come in to the card surface.

Tip - if you want specific colors to show up for specific words, use the die as a guide for how much to ink blend of each color.



2. In the sample, the blending started with the yellow in the middle. Then the red was added on one side and blended over into the yellow to create the orange. The blue was added on the other side of the yellow creating green at the overlap.

The result is a rainbow across the card front.



3. Die cut the wording - Center the die on the ink blended cardstock. Use a die cutting machine to die cut the wording out.



4. Remove die cut wording and other pieces. Save all of the pieces for now.



5. Card #1 - Using the card front

With the wrong side facing up, add glue to the back of the cardstock piece with the wording removed. Keep the glue layer thin and spread glue so that the glue does not ooze out later.



6. Carefully turn the piece over and center onto a blank card front. Glue down



7. Like working on a puzzle, place the die cut wording and other pieces back into the card front piece.

One by one, lift out each non-wording piece and add a little glue. Put the pieces back into place and glue down. Be careful not to get glue onto the main wording piece.



8. When all the smaller inner pieces are glued down, lift out the whole wording piece.

The card base should show through leaving the wording to see.



9. Card #1 is done and can be further embellished as you want. Here we added stamped images from a set that coordinates with the die and some sequin jewelz.



10. Card #2 - using just the wording die cut. Take the wording die cut and place it on the second card base. Glue down.

Card #2 is done and can be further embellished as you want.

NOTE: You can add a mat to the card base before placing the wording on.
