





## WITCH HAT TREAT HOLDER

## **SUPPLIES & TOOLS**

- Accu Cut Pyramid Box #4 3D Die\*
- 8.5-in. x 11-in Black Cardstock for Pyramid Box for Witch Hat
- 6-in. x 6-in. Black Cardstock for Witch Hat Brim
- DVD or similar for tracing an approx. 4.75-in. Circle
- · Pencil for tracing
- Double Stick Tape # 30013284
- Scissors
- 1-in. x 3-in. Cardstock for Message Strip
- Stamps or pens for writing message
- · Embellishments ribbon, stamped images, stickers, etc. to add to the witch hat

**NOTE:** The Accu Cut Die Cutting system is available for use at the HouseMart Ben Franklin Crafts stores. You can use the system for free when you purchase your paper from the stores. Most stores have the Pyramid Box #4 die available for cutting.



## **INSTRUCTIONS**



1. Use the Accu Cut die cutting machine and to cut out a Pyramid Box #4 from black cardstock.



5. Center and tape the pyramid box to the black circle.

The side with the semi-circle notches will be the front




2. Fold and crease all the fold lines.



6. Write a message or name on the 1-in. x 3-in. strip. Slide the message strip between the notched tabs.

Decorate the message strip and the rest of the witch hat.



3. Add double stick tape to the end section.

Fold and tape pyramid box together.



7. Open the bottom of the box and fill with treats.



4. Trace around a DVD on the black cardstock. Cut out circle. You can also use a die or Cricut machine to cut out the circle.



8. You can also make other designs with the pyramid box like this Candy Corn. The Candy Corn layered the orange and white cardstocks on top of a yellow cardstock base.

You could also make it by using a white base and in blending the orange and yellow sections.
