



PAPER ORNAMENT BALL

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 9 Cardstock Circles - Double-sided print, any size (2-in. to 3-in suggested)
- Craft Glue dots (1/2-in.) #30001508
- 8 to 12 inches of cord or ribbon for a hanger
- Stapler, Sewing Machine or Glue Gun



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Cut out nine circles using a die cutting machine, paper punch or you can trace and hand cut.

Fold each circle in half.



2. Stack the circles up, alternating the printed side up.



3. Staple the circles together at the center fold. Or, you can use a sewing machine or light glue gun.



4. Take the ribbon or cord for the hanger and knot the ends together.

Place the cord with the knotted end at the bottom, along the center spine and glue down.



5. Place a glue dot close to the edge at the bottom of the right side of the circle.



6. Fold that circle half over to the left side of the circle half; gluing them together.



7. On the next right-side circle half, place a glue dot at the top half. Fold that circle half over to the left side of the circle half; gluing them together.



8. Repeat steps 5 through 7, alternating the glue dots on the bottom or the top. When you have glued the circles together, it will have this finished design.
