



FALL INSPIRED DECORATED JARS

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Small - 3" Glass Jar with lid #30220819
- Large - 3 1/2" x 7" Round Glass Jar w/ lid #30212127
- Alcohol Ink - Bright Sunset (Orange) #30141385
- Americana Multi Surface Acrylic Paint - Cotton Ball (White) #30141038
- Americana Multi Surface Acrylic Paint - Canary (Yellow) #30141052
- Acrylic Multi surface Acrylic Paint - Pumpkin Patch (Orange) #30141049
- Artist Silk Sponge #77514083
- Alcohol Ink Applicator or Felt Scrap or pom pom
- Black Sharpie #91029 or Paint Marker
- 48" of raffia, twine or ribbon
- Cardstock for Tag and green cardstock for leaves
- Fine tip Marker for writing
- 1/8" Hole Punch #77178541
- Scissors
- T-Lite Candle - battery-operated
- Pop Up Glue Dot



NOTE: Wash and dry jars. To make sure there is no residues, wipe down the outside of the jar with rubbing alcohol or similar.

INSTRUCTIONS



1. Pumpkin Jar -
Take the small 3" Glass Jar and remove the lid. Apply a few drops of orange alcohol ink onto an alcohol ink applicator (or felt piece, pom pom).

Blot ink onto the outside of the jar, coloring the jar completely orange.



2. Use the black paint/permanent marker and draw a jack o' lantern face on one side of the jar. Let dry.



3. Use a Pop Up glue dot and attach a battery operated T-Lite to the inside of the jar lid.

Switch T-Lite on. Screw lid back onto the jar.



4. Pumpkin Jar finishing -
Wrap raffia several times around the edge of the jar lid. Bunch some up and make a bow and tie on.

Cut out small leaves from green cardstock and tie onto the raffia.

Make a tag with a message and tie on if you want.



5. Candy Corn Jar -
Take the large 3 1/2" x 7" Round Glass Jar and remove the lid. Dab the sea sponge into the white paint. Sponge paint the top third of the outside of the jar. Let dry.



6. Sponge paint the middle third of the jar with the yellow paint. Let dry.

Sponge paint the bottom third of the jar with the orange paint. Let dry.



7. Candy Corn Jar Finishing -
You can use the painted jar as is with or without the lid.

You can also use the black marker to make a kawaii face for a whimsical look.



8. Candy Corn Jar Finishing Suggestions -

- Add a T-Lite to the jar to use it as a decoration.
- Fill the jar with treats.
- Leave the lid off and use as a vase or pencil holder.
- Place lid on and tie ribbon/twine around and add a tag like the pumpkin jar.
