



# NUTS & SCREWS PHOTO HOLDER

## SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 2 qty. Jumbo Craft Sticks #77676437
- 2 qty. 1 1/2" long screws - fully threaded
- 2 qty. matching nuts
- Washi Tape, Paint, etc. to decorate the crafts sticks
- Ruler
- Pencil
- We R Crop-a-dile Multi Punch #30208986, We R Crop-a-dile Hole Punch #30067868 and Eyelet Setter or Fiskars Hand drill #30065910

**NOTE:** The Craft stick sample used Steel Machine Screws and nuts in size 10-24 x 1 1/2"



## INSTRUCTIONS



1. Take a jumbo craft stick and measure 1/2" in from the end and mark with a pencil. Make a larger pencil mark that is centered from the top and bottom of the stick. Measure and mark the other end of the stick. Mark the holes as evenly spaced on both sides as possible.



5. Decorate the craft stick with paints, washi tape, stickers, etc. You just need to decorate one side of one stick.



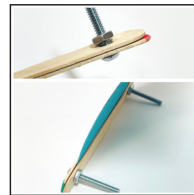
2. Place the stick in the We R Crop-a-dile Multi punch, set at a 1/4" hole. Center the Crop-a-dile hole over the marked point on the craft stick.



6. Place the two craft sticks together, the decorated side facing out. Match the holes up. Insert the screws in the holes from the front to the back.



3. Squeeze punch to make the hole. Be careful because the small wood piece may pop out of the punch.



7. Twist the nuts onto the screws. Slip a photo in between the two sticks. Loosen the nut if needed and then re-tighten.



4. Use the punch to make a hole on the other side of the jumbo craft stick. Make the holes as evenly spaced as possible.

Line this craft stick up with the second craft stick. Use the pencil to mark the holes, punch out the holes.



8. You can use this technique with other substrates like clipboards or just a canvas panel like in the second sample shown above.

You can glue buttons, flowers, stickers, etc. over the screw tops on the front to decorate them if you like.



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
