



SIMPLE MAC NUT POUCH* FAVOR

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 6 in. x 6 in. Cardstock – solid or double-sided print
- Score Board #30195075 or #30193342 (with trimmer)
- Paper Creaser #30003774 (or use the one from the Score Board)
- Paper Trimmer #30174692
- High Tack Double Stick Tape #30219172
- Aleene’s Fast Grab Tacky Glue #30172710
- Scissors
- Embellishments – Tags, Stickers, Ribbon, etc. to adorn your favor
- Wrapped treats for the inside of the favor



NOTE: This favor is often called the Sour Cream Container but in Hawaii we see it as the Mac Nut pouch.
This version does not tape both ends closed, so it is recloseable keeping the favor intact.

Take note of the direction of the print on the paper when cutting the 6 in. x 6 in. size so that the design is how you want it on the favor.

INSTRUCTIONS



1. Take the 6 in. x 6 in. cardstock and place it on the Score Board. On one edge, score at 3/8 in. On the opposite end score at the 5-5/8-in. mark.

NOTE: Take note of the direction of the print on the paper when placing it down for scoring if it has a one-way design.

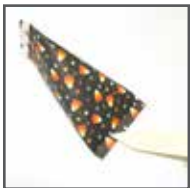


3. Run the scoring tool along the backside edge of the favor top, slightly curving the paper. Do the same at the bottom edge of the paper.

This will help make the paper roll and overlap easier.



5. Carefully, roll the cardstock together, overlapping and taping the side edges together. This forms a tube.



7. On the other end of the tube, flatten the tube in the opposite direction. The double stick tape will help keep this bottom end closed.

This creates the Mac Nut Pouch look.

2. With the right-side print down, fold over at the scored 3/8 in. line. Use the scoring tool to make a nice crease. Fold over one more time and crease well. Unfold and add double stick tape or glue. Refold and glue down. This will be the opening side of the favor.



4. With the wrong side of the favor facing up, place double stick tape along one side edge. Place a strip of double stick tape, about 2 in. long, at the bottom edge at the corner.



6. Position the overlapped edges seam in the center of the tube, then flatten the top edge closed. Use the paper creaser to help reinforce the closure.

The folded over edges help create a recloseable opening.



8. Embellish the outside of the favor with stickers, tags, ribbons and more. Slightly squeeze the top open and place wrapped treats inside. Flatten edge and press together to close.
