



## SURPRISE TREATS STREAMER BALLS

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Crepe Paper Streamer roll – color match to the character you want to make
- Meriken 1/4" Double Sided Tape - #30013284
- Cardstock Scraps for the characters face, ears, etc. or stickers
- Scissors
- Small treats and toys to wrap (wrapped candy, novelty erasers, small toys, money, etc.)
- Ribbon
- Black sharpie marker #91029

#### NOTE:

- \* Streamer colors - orange #77600239 for a pumpkin, light green #30167175 for Frankenstein or a witch, white #77600197 for a ghost or mummy, etc.



### INSTRUCTIONS



1) Start with a larger treat or toy for the center. Carefully wrap the streamer around the treat/toy while forming a ball.



2) Keep wrapping and adding more treats/toys throughout. Use a little double stick tape if needed to hold down the streamer as you wrap.



3) When there is just about 3" - 4" left of the streamer, wrap it around and add a little double stick tape to hold it in place but leave at least a 1" tail. The tail helps show you where to start unraveling from.



4) Decorate your streamer ball however you wish. Add eyes, nose, mouth, hair and/or a hat to create a character. Or, you can just add stickers around.

You can incorporate the tail as part of the design. For the witch, we twisted up the tail and used it for the witch's nose. The face details were drawn with a black Sharpie marker.



5) Give the decorated streamer ball with a note to unravel to find hidden treasures. That's when the fun really starts to happen as little treats/toys fall out as they unravel their streamer ball.
