RIBBON ANGEL

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 2-1/2 yds. of 2 1/2 in. ribbon for the body
- 2 yds. of 1-1/2 in. ribbon for the wings, coordinating color
- 3 in. Unbreakable Ornament Ball - coordinating color for the head
- 24 in. of 5/8 in. sheer ribbon for bow at the neck and hanger
- Small floral picks for embellishment and halo
- Scissors
- Low Temp Glue Gun & Glue Sticks



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Measure and cut the ribbon into five pieces each 18 in. in length.



2. Fold ribbons in half. Glue the ends together and scrunching them up at the same time.



3. Place one ribbon in the middle and the two ribbons on the outer sides. Glue all three ribbon loops. Take the last two ribbons loops and glue to the back.

4. Take the ornament ball and cut off the cording. Turn the ornament upside down so that the ornament top/hanger is at the bottom. Place ornament on top of the gathered loops and glue in place.



5. Take the 1-1/2 in. ribbon for the wings and make a small loopy bow about 10 in. wide. Make the bow with 2 - 4 loops.



6. Glue the bow behind the ornament ball for the wings.



7. You can cut small pieces from a floral pick and glue under the neck for decoration. Make a small bow with the sheer ribbon. Glue to the neck, just under the ornament ball, hiding the glued area of the gathered ribbon loops.



8. You can make a halo with glitter stem or wire garland and spot glue to the top of the ornament ball head. To make into an ornament, you can make a short loop with the sheer ribbon and glue to the back above the wings.
