



EASY PAINTED SNOWMAN ORNAMENT

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Flat Disk Clear - Shatterproof, Glass or Fillable Ornament
- Multi-Surface Acrylic Paint - White (Cottonball)
- Paint Markers or Acrylic Paint in these colors: Black, Orange, Brown and Red
- Sea Sponge or similar
- Paint Palette or similar
- Thin fine tip paintbrush
- Faux Snow for filler
- Ribbon for bow
- Scissors



INSTRUCTIONS



1. First make sure the surface of the ornament is clean and dry. Pour some white paint onto your palette or similar. Add just a little paint onto a small corner of the sea sponge. Next, lightly dab the paint onto the ornament, creating a rounded half circle near the bottom for the snowman's body.



2. Next, dab paint a smaller circle above for the snowman's head. Let dry.



3. Paint the face - Use the end of the paintbrush to make dip dot eyes with the black paint. Let dry. Add a tiny dot of white on each eye for a highlight. Let dry.



4. For the carrot nose - use the orange paint to make a rounded, long triangle below the eyes. For the mouth - use less black paint on the end of the brush and make five smaller dip dots in a half circle below the nose. Let dry.



5. Add arms by painting thin brown branch-like lines coming out from the body. Draw a red heart on the left side of the chest. Let dry.



6. You can fill the ornament with faux snow. If you painted a fillable ornament, you can even add in a small gift like rolled up money!



7. Tie a bow at the top of the ornament to finish. You can paint the snowman in different poses, too!
