MINI RIBBON ANGEL

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 8 in. of 2-1/2 in. Wired Ribbon for the body
- 16 - 18 inches of 1-1/2-in. Wired Ribbon - coordinating color for the wings
- 2 in. Mini Ornament ball - coordinating color
- 12 in. Glitter Stem or similar for halo
- 8 in. of sheer 3/8 in. ribbon for neck bow
- Pinback - if making into a wearable pin
- Scissors
- Low Temp Glue Gun & Glue Sticks



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Take the 8 in. length of the 2-1/2-in. wired ribbon and fold in half. Glue the ends together while scrunching them up.



2. Take the 16 to 18 in. of the 1-1/2 in. wired ribbon and cross fold ends over to make a bow.



3. Use one end of the 12 in. glitter stem to cinch the ribbon in the middle. Keep the rest of the glitter stem at the top.

4. Center and place the gathered ribbon piece on top of the bow and glue in place.



5. If you are making a pin - Take the mini ornament ball and remove the ornament cap. Turn upside down and glue to the top of the ribbon for the angel head.

If you are using as an ornament, leave the ornament cap on and glue to the ribbon with the cap on the top.



6. Take the glitter stem and shape it into a circle for the halo.



7. Make a tiny bow with the sheer ribbon and glue at the neck. If making a pin, glue the pin back behind the bow.
