## LAWN FAWN STAR BOX

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Lawn Fawn Star Box Die #30252685
- Cardstock – solid or printed
- Sizzix Big Shot Die Cutting System #30245922 or similar
- 3/16-in. Double stick tape #30013283

Extras:

- Cording for ornament hanging
- 3/16-in. x 12-in. Wood dowel #77187634 for wand
- Ribbons for wand
- Stamped & Colored images, stickers, buttons, etc.
- Scissors
- Foam adhesive dots #30219133



### INSTRUCTIONS



1. Follow the Sizzix Big Shot directions and use the die to cut out a Star Box.



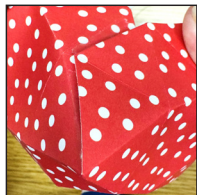
2. Slightly crease at the lines created when the die was cut out.



3. Notice that the on the die cut piece, there are 6 triangles along the edge that have an “x” in the center.

Add double stick tape within these 6 triangles.

Carefully remove the protective tape liners.



4. Because you pre-creased the lines, folding the box up should be easy.

Start by bringing the outer edges together. Match up the sections like a puzzle.



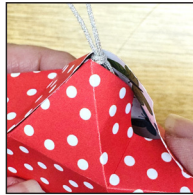
5. As you fit the sections together, press the taped sections securely.

Work your way around the star box.



6. The star box will take shape. You will end up with the opening with the two half notched sections.

The two flaps are folded down to close like a pillow box.



7. Decorate the outside with stamped images, stickers, buttons and more!

Use as a favor or for a small gift.

Add a piece of cording for hanger to make an ornament.



8. Use on top of a small wood dowel with ribbons to make a fairy wand.

String a bunch together to make a garland.

Lot of creative ways to use the star box!
