

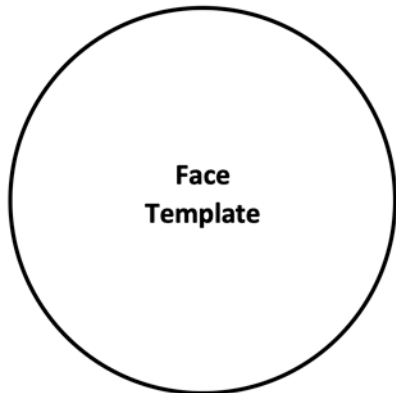
## INSTRUCTIONS (continued)



17. Place the broom in front of the witch's body with the broom handle between the arms. Glue in place.



18. Take the nose and glue to the face below the eyes.

## SUPPLIES

- 7 in. Paper Mache Cone (#30212439)
  - Black Acrylic Paint (#77624890)
  - Bright Green Acrylic Paint (Delta Ceramcoat - Gecko #3008495)
  - White Acrylic Paint (#77624882)
  - White Hearty Clay (#30006454)
  - 9 in. x 6 in. Black Felt (half of a felt sheet) (#77676643)
  - Orange Yarn (Sugar 'n Cream - Hot Orange) (#30058447)
  - 2 in. x 4 in. Scrap cardstock or thin cardboard for hair template
  - 12 in. length of Glitter Tulle - Purple or any other color
  - 1 in. x 4 in. Brown Cardstock
  - Raffia #30147008
- Optional: Wood toothpick or similar for the broom

## TOOLS:

- Pencil for tracing
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Paintbrush - medium for large area painting
- Thin handle Paintbrush - for details
- Low Temp Glue Gun & Glue Sticks

## INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Cut out and trace the Face Template on the cone about 2 inches from the bottom with a pencil. (refer to Face Template on back of sheet)

Paint inside the traced circle with the green acrylic paint. Let dry.



2. Paint the rest of the outside of the cone with the black acrylic paint. Let dry.



3. Eyes - Use the thinner paintbrush and paint two white circles on the green face for the eyes. Let dry.



4. Use the rounded end of the thin paintbrush and make a small dot of black paint on the white eyes. Let dry.

Use the rounded end of the thin paintbrush and make a tiny dip dot of white paint on the black for a highlight. Let dry.



5. **Nose** - Take a small piece of white Hearty Clay and roll into a small cone about 1/2 in. tall for the nose. Make the bottom base flat.

Paint the Hearty Clay with the green acrylic paint. Let dry. Set aside for later.

TIP: Stick a wood toothpick or similar through the bottom of the nose for easier painting and drying.



6. **Hair** - Take the 2 x 4 in. cardstock and fold in half to make it 2 x 2 in. Use this to wind yarn around. Make a small bundle of about 10 yarn loops for the bangs.



7. Slide the yarn bundle off of hair template and use a short piece of yarn to tie in the middle of the bundle. Cut loops apart on both sides, this is for the bangs.



8. Wind yarn around the hair template 20 - 30 times. Take a short piece of yarn and this time, slip under the loops of yarn, leaving the yarn still on the template. Tie the short yarn together at one end and knot securely. Slip the yarn loop bundle off the template. Cut loops apart. Make three more yarn bundles.



9. Center the bangs bundle above the front of the face and glue in place.



10. Glue the rest of the yarn hair bundles around the cone at the same height. Trim the yarn to shape the hair. You can keep the yarn ends uneven to give it a more witchy look. Optional - you can also untwist the yarn to give the hair a frizzier look.



11. **Witch Hat** - Take the black felt circle. (refer to Hat Brim pattern on back of sheet) Fold in half twice so it is a quarter size.

At the center tip, cut a curve about 1/2 in. inwards. Unfold the felt revealing a 1 in. circle in the center. Place over the cone and bring down to the top of the hair. Remove and trim the center of the circle if needed.



12. Take the hat circle in both hands and carefully pull along the edges, stretching the felt. Stretching the felt creates a wavy hat brim.



13. Place the felt hat brim back onto the cone so it sits on the top of the hair. Glue hat brim onto the hair. Take a 12 in. length of glitter tulle or ribbon and make a bow. Glue bow to the hat.



14. **Arms** - Cut two 1-1/2 in. x 2 in. black felt strips. Take one of the black felt strips. Fold the 1-1/2 in. width into thirds, overlapping the ends. Glue ends down creating a 2 in. long tube.

Place on the front of the body at an angle below the face for the arms, with the top end covered by the hair. Trim the length if it's too long. Glue in place.



15. **Broom** - Take the brown cardstock and twist and scrunch it to give it a distressed look. Roll the cardstock into a tube to make the broom handle. Glue the overlapped edges.

Optional: You can wrap the cardstock over a wood toothpick to make it sturdier.



16. Make a small bundle from raffia about 2 in. tall but do not tie in the middle. Insert one end of the cardstock broom handle into the center of one end of the raffia. Take another piece of raffia and wrap around the top of the bundle securing the raffia onto the broom handle.

Cut raffia loops apart and trim.
