





PULL UP TREAT HOLDER

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 6 1/2-inch H x 7 1/2-inch L Cardstock for holder base *for Peanut M&Ms
- Cardstock for embellishment/sentiment
- 28 to 36-inches length of Ribbon no wider than the 5/8-inch
- 1/4-inch Double stick tape #30013284
- 1/4-inch Hole Punch
- Score Board
- Scissors
- Ruler and pencil/pen
- Stamped Images, cut-outs, stickers, etc. for embellishment

NOTE: The sample was made using a Peanut M&Ms bag. The same measurements can be used for a Nestle Crunch bar.

- Kit Kat bar 4 1/2-inch H x 7 1/2-inch L
- · Adjust the cardstock measurements for the holder to accommodate other sizes of candy.



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Place the 6 1/2-inch x 7 1/2-inch cardstock onto the scoreboard with the 7 1/2-inch edge along the top.

Score at the following marks: 1/2-inch, 3 1/2-inch, 4-inch, and 7-inch.



5. Insert the candy bar into the holder by placing it onto the center of the ribbon and slowly pushing it down into the holder.



2. Crease all the scored lines.

Place double stick tape on the last 1/2-inch section

Fold the holder up, overlapping the 1/2-inch sections on the two ends. Overlap and tape together.



6. Bring the ends of the ribbon together and tie into a bow at the top of the holder.

The ribbon will hold the candy bar in place.



3. Use the ruler to find the middle of the holder front and make a small mark. Take the 1/4-inch hole punch and make a hole at the center top of the holder about 1/2-inch from the top edge.

Punch the hole through both thicknesses of the holder.



7. To get the candy bar, just until the bow and pull the ribbon up. The candy bar will slide up and out of the holder.



4. Take the ends of the ribbon and thread it through the two holes going from the inside to the outside. Have the ends of the ribbon coming out at the top. Keep the ends of the ribbon evenly matched.



8. Decorate the front of the holder as desired.
