SNOWMAN HOOP

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 6 in. Wood Embroidery Hoop
- 9 in. x 12 in. White Felt
- 3 in. x 3 in. Black Foamie
- 2 in. x 3 in. Orange Foamie
- 2 in. x 4 in. Red Felt
- 2 qty. - 20mm Moving Eyes
- 18" in. of 1-1/2 in. Christmas Ribbon
- 12 in. of 1/4 in. Ribbon for a hanger
- Christmas pick
- Scissors
- Low Temp Glue Gun & Glue sticks



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Separate the two pieces of the wood embroidery hoop.

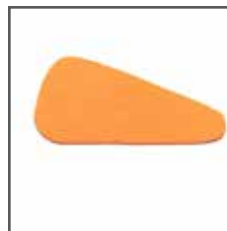


2. Place the white felt over the inner ring. Place the outer ring over, stretching the felt so it is taut. Tighten the screw to secure. From the back, trim off excess felt around the hoop.



3. Place the 20mm moving eyes 1/3 down from the top screw. Glue in place.

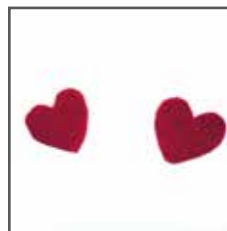

4. From the Orange foamie, cut a rounded triangle for a "carrot nose" and glue in place below the eyes.



5. Take the black foamie and cut out five circular shapes for the "coal". Line them up below the nose as in the sample and glue in place for the mouth.



6. Take the red felt and cut two hearts for the "cheeks". Place one on either side of the mouth and glue in place.



7. Take the Christmas pick and glue to the bottom of the hoop, on one side



8. Take the 18 in. of the 1-1/2 in. Christmas ribbon and make into a bow. Glue the bow by the pick. Take the 1/4 in. ribbon and tie to the hoop's screw at the top for a hanger.
