



HEARTY CLAY SNOWMAN

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- White Hearty Clay - #77856070
- Coco Brown Foamie - #30041092
- Black E- beads or similar for eyes
- Black Acrylic Paint - #77624890
- Red Acrylic Paint - #77624866
- Orange Acrylic Paint - #77627810
- Wood toothpicks or similar
- Tacky Glue - #1360916
- Thin Paintbrush
- Low Temp Glue Gun & Glue Sticks
- Sharp Scissors
- **Optional** - Paper Clip, Wood Slice Base, Christmas Picks, Sisal Tree, Mini Star Garland, Glitter Snowflakes



INSTRUCTIONS



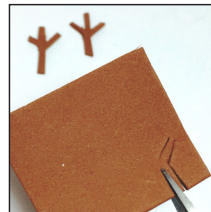
1. Pinch off some white Hearty Clay and roll into a ball the size that you want the snowman's body to be. Roll another ball slightly smaller for the head.



5. Break off a 1" length from a wood toothpick or mini wooden dowel. Stick into the top of the larger clay ball body. Add a little Tacky Glue around, and then place the head on top.



2. Take the head and create the face. For the eyes, you can push in two small black beads. Or, you can use the end of a thin paintbrush and dip dot black acrylic paint for the eyes and let dry.



6. Add hands by cutting "branches" from brown foamie. Make a small hole on both the sides of the body, add a little Tacky Glue and slide hands into the hole. Let dry.

Add any other decorations to your snowman.



3. Add a mouth by dip dot painting a semi-circle with black paint. Make the dots smaller than the eyes.

TIP: Unbend a paperclip and use the end to make the small dip dots.



7. You can use your snowman as part of a scene inside of a clear fillable ball or add onto a wood disk as shown.

If you want to make it into an ornament, add a hanger to the top by pushing in an eye screw or wire loop. Check the hanger and add glue if needed.



4. For the "Carrot nose" you can paint a triangle below the eyes with orange acrylic paint. Or you can take a little Hearty Clay and roll it into a small cone shape. Let it dry and paint it with the orange paint. Glue the nose below the eyes using a Low Temp Glue Gun or Tacky Glue.
